Smoky and soft with classic grassy, gooseberry and grapefruit characteristics.

<b>Chateauneuf-du-Pape 'Les Olivets', Roger Sabon, Rhone Valley, France 2019</b> Gorgeous with raspberries, black cherries and herb lead garrigue. This is full-bodied and finished off with mocha and liquorice.	£80
<b>Chateau La Fleur d Bouard, Lalande-de-Pomerol, Bordeaux, France, 2014</b> Crispy ripe tannins, layers of blackberry and blueberry fruits, laced with hints of cinnamon and cedar oak.	£82
<b>Volnay, Dom. Henri Boillot, Burgundy, France, 2021</b> On the nose, ripe berries-silky-delicate-cherries on the palate, delicate with silky tannins.	£190

### ITALY
